WITNESS INTERVIEW REPORT: DANIEL MCANASPIE

On February 6th, 2013, from approximately 1000 hours to 1040 hours, I met with witness, Det. McAnaspie within the Newtown Police Department and obtained a written statement. In summary, Det. McAnaspie stated that on 12/14/12, he and Det. Joudy were transporting a prisoner to Danbury Superior Court. As they arrived at the courthouse, at approximately 0935 hours, they heard Dispatcher Nuite dispatch units to Sandy Hook School for a sound of broken glass and possible shots fired. They left their prisoner with the Judicial Marshalls and responded to the School. Upon arrival approximately 10-15 minutes after the initial dispatch, Det. McAnapsie left the vehicle in the center of the parking lot. Det. McAnaspie observed several Newtown cruisers in the lot. They both then ran towards the school where they observed Capt. Rios on the playground side of the building. They approached Capt. Rios who instructed them to cover the side entrance/exits. They took up posts at the different locations. Det. McAnaspie secured the exit closest to the playground. At this time, he observed multiple State Troopers take up perimeter positions. Shortly after, he observed Officers evacuating teachers and children through the exit he was located at. Det. McAnaspie positioned himself between them and the school windows. When the all clear was given, he and Det. Joudy went to the front of the school and met up with Newtown Officers. They were advised that there were multiple fatalities. Det. McAnaspie was instructed by Lt. Vanghele that he would be assisting the Western District Major Crime Squad. For the next six days, Det. McAnaspie assisted in the processing of the interior of the school and victims (See attached statement for details.)

On May 24th, 2013, at approximately 1030 hours, I met with Det. McAnaspie at the Newtown Police Department. I asked Det. McAnaspie clarifying questions about his aforementioned written statement. Det. McAnaspie stated that he did not recognize any of the State Troopers taking up
