ACTION TAKEN:

On 06/05/13, I received the supplemental reports from the State Police Emergency Services Unit which detailed their response and actions at Sandy Hook Elementary School and the Lanza Residence at 36 Yogananda St. in Newtown, CT. A report written by TFC Voket described the response and actions of both the West Team and East Team at Sandy Hook Elementary School. A report written by TFC Rief describes the East Team's response and action at 36 Yogananda St. in Newtown, CT. (See attached supplemental reports)




Action Taken: On the morning of 12/14/12 sniper training was conducted at Brainard Airport in Hartford, CT. Present at the training were the snipers from both East and West tactical teams, Sergeant Palen, TFC Rief and I. Snipers were Sgt. Alogna, Sgt. Dubuc, Sgt. Bistany, Sgt. Cauley, Sgt. Albert, Sgt. Corey, Sgt. Girard, TFC Chapman and TFC Lavoie.


At approximately 0935 hours I received a cell phone call from a team mate, Tpr. Poach. Tpr. Poach advised me that he was enroute to the Sandy Hook Elementary School for an active shooting incident. TFC Poach added that he had been told that a man was inside the school shooting students. Tpr. Poach also provided me with the address of 12 Dickenson Dr. Sandy Hook.

I passed this information along to Sgt. Palen and the rest of the snipers at training. Sgt. Palen confirmed what Tpr. Poach had provided and related that the West tactical team was being called out. At approximately 0940 hours we left Brainard Airport and responded to the Sandy Hook Elementary School.

At approximately 0954 hours, while enroute to the Sandy Hook Elementary School the West tactical team received the callout request via Everbridge messaging.

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Action Taken: (Cont.)

While enroute several scene updates were received from message center dispatcher's by way of radio broadcasts. Several messages that the scene was still active, multiple gunmen, and numerous DOA victims were received. Just as we arrived a broadcast was received that one gunman was down and searches for a second shooter were being conducted.


The responding team members from sniper training arrived as a group at approximately 1015 hours. We parked alongside the road on Riverside Rd., near the intersection of Dickenson Dr. It was impossible to get any closer because of the large volume of response vehicles blocking Dickenson Dr.

Team members put on their kit and ran up to the school. As we ran towards the school we put together a stack order and hasty search plan. At the front of the school we met up with additional team mates, Troopers Faughnan, Poach, Gomez and Beauton. As we approached the front entrance of the school we could see that the window to the right of the front door was shattered. Broken glass covered the ground beneath the window. What appeared to be bullet casings from a .223 caliber rifle were seen on the concrete patio area. Also observed was a pool of blood and 12, 03 on the concrete just outside of the school front door. I entered the school and met with Lt. Perry, who standing in the lobby area outside of the main office. As I was speaking with Lt. Perry, Sgt.'s Alogna and Bistany 13, 14

Inside the office were numerous State Police personnel, including command staff, unknown plain clothes personnel, and uniformed ambulance personnel. I observed a large room to the right of the main office, at the beginning of the right side hallway, was full of what appeared to be first responders, plain clothed troopers wearing raid jackets, uniformed troopers and ambulance personnel. To the right of Lt. Perry were the bodies of two adult females 12, 03. Lt. Perry told me that the school had been evacuated and the first few rooms were searched, he pointed to his right at the classrooms that were searched. He stressed that the school had not been cleared. Lt. Perry stated that one shooter was down and that the possibility of a second shooter existed. He also told me that there were numerous police officers posted in the hallways and at entrance/exits within the school. Lt. Perry further stated that he was going to remain where he was and if there was anything I needed to let him know.

Sgt.'s Alogna and Bistany [REDACTED] 13, 14

[REDACTED]. As we moved down the hallway we observed numerous spent .223 rifle casings strewn about the hallway floor and the distinct smell of fired ammunition was present. Also observed in the hallway was a partially filled AR-15 style magazine and several unfired .223 caliber cartridges on the ground.



Numerous dead children and teachers were seen in classrooms 10 and 8. It appeared that many of the children and teachers had been shot in the head and body. 12, 03

These classrooms were searched by team members without touching or disturbing any of the victims. In classroom 8 the body of the gunman was found dead of an apparent gunshot wound to the head, lying in somewhat of a fetal position. Yellow ear plugs could be seen in one of his ears and he had two handguns near or on his body. An AR-15 style rifle was also seen on the floor in classroom 8. The rifle appeared to have had a malfunction of some sort. The bolt was out of battery and at least one round could be seen in the chamber area.

Team members continued with their primary sweep and relieved police personnel that were posted in the hallways prior to our arrival. These personnel were comprised mostly of BCI investigators with a few plain clothed officers from surrounding towns. While searching the media center I encountered a female teacher who approached me as I entered the room. She stated that she had been hiding once she heard the shooting. I did not get her name but she is a 04 [REDACTED]. There were some troopers in the hallway as we exited and I passed her along to them who in turn escorted her out of the building. We continued the clockwise sweep of the school and eventually met up with Sgt. Alogna and Bistany.

I radioed to Sgt. Palen in our command post that the primary search was complete and that we were going to start the secondary search. I also requested a master key to open locked doors. I was told that several other team members had arrived and that the FBI SWAT team from New Haven was on scene and would be assisting. The initial search team met up with FBI SWAT and divided up the secondary search efforts. SPTU conducted a secondary search from the main lobby area and swept clockwise, researching the school. Additional team members utilized for the secondary search were; Troopers O'Donnell, Wyler, Lunz, Cook, Basak and

Avery. FBI SWAT conducted a secondary search of the school from the lobby and swept counter clockwise. Both teams eventually met up and continued their searches overlapping what had already been searched by each respective team. It should be noted that although we had a master key numerous doors, cabinets and lockers had to be forced open by pry or push tools because the key did not work. SPTU personnel and FBI SWAT members consolidated outside in front of the school following the searches. I met with Captain Fusaro and Sgt. Palen and reported that primary and secondary searches of the school had been conducted and that the school was secure. Team members remained in the area pending further assignments.

A short time later team members were assigned to search the suspect's residence at 36 Yoganada St. in Newtown. Team members travelled to the area of Yoganada St. and met up with East Team members, RG-12 armoured vehicle and bomb squad personnel. A hasty perimeter was established around the suspect residence with snipers from both teams while an execution plan was being made. Traffic was blocked on Yoganada St. and Newtown police officers were relieved from their positions in the suspect's driveway. Team members approached the suspect residence in the RG-12. We parked in an adjacent driveway and the perimeter consisting of the sniper teams was reinforced by East Team members. The plan was



██████████ e Captain Fusaro advised us that he had received word that people were found alive hiding at the school and that the West team was to report back to the school to research it. The East Team remained on site at the suspect residence and conducted the search efforts. Refer to TFC Rief's supplementary report.

West Team members responded directly back to the Sandy Hook Elementary School and met with Major Meraviglia in the lobby area inside the school, directly in front of the main office. Major Meraviglia stated that he had located two females, 03, 04 ██████████ inside the main office where the command post was located, and demanded that the school be researched.

West Team members along with FBI SWAT personnel researched the school. Primary and secondary searches were conducted. No other individuals were located. Team members remained on scene until approximately 2200 hours.

7.) Upon arrival to school was assigned to the right-side hallway and began clearing. Cleared cafe/gymnasium, kitchen and then rooms down hallway until we met up with Team that went left upon arrival. Met up at end of right-side hallway.

- I was initially w/Chick Bistany.
- Once initial search was complete, a secondary search was completed which I was part of. Started in same direction, clearing same rooms, until we got to the center of the back hallway. Once that was completed I proceeded back to the front of the school via the left-side hallway and then exited the school to the front parking lot. From that point a few of us went to a couple out buildings behind the school and searched those.

SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT – STATE POLICE TACTICAL OPERATIONS
LANZA RESIDENCE 36 YOGANANDA STREET NEWTOWN, CONNECTICUT

DATE AND TIME OF INCIDENT: On 12/14/12 between 1147 hours and 1755 hours.

PLACE OF INCIDENT: Lanza Residence 36 Yogananda Street Newtown, Connecticut


SUMMARY OF INCIDENT: On 12/14/12 at approximately 0930 hours an Active Shooter Incident occurred at the Sandy Hook Elementary School located at 12 Dickenson Drive Newtown, Connecticut. Twenty (20) school children and six (6) adult faculty members were murdered by Adam Lanza. Adam Lanza subsequently committed suicide during the incident. State Police Tactical Unit (SPTU) West and East Personnel responded to the Active Shooter Incident and conducted Tactical Operations. Upon completion of Tactical Operations at the school, SPTU West and East Personnel, and ESU Bomb Squad Personnel, were assigned to conduct Tactical Operations at the residence of Adam Lanza located at 36 Yogananda Street Newtown, Connecticut. SPTU West and East conducted Tactical Operations at the Lanza residence, clearing and securing the residence. Nancy Lanza, homeowner and mother of Adam Lanza, was located deceased in bed in the master bedroom from an apparent gunshot wound.

ACTION TAKEN: On 12/14/12 while at Sandy Hook Elementary School 12 Dickenson Drive Newtown, Connecticut and shortly after having completed Tactical Operations at an Active Shooter Incident at the school, Captain Fusaro, SPTU Commander and Emergency Services Unit (ESU) Commanding Officer, assigned SPTU West and East Personnel to respond to the Lanza residence 36 Yogananda Street Newtown, Connecticut. Captain Fusaro said Adam Lanza, the deceased suspect in the Sandy Hook Elementary School Shootings earlier that day, resided at this location. Captain Fusaro said Connecticut State Police Personnel had made telephone calls to the residence with negative contact. Further, that no one had located or heard from the parents of Adam Lanza that day. Additionally, there was concern that a second shooter may have been involved in the Active Shooter Incident at the school earlier that day, as reported by some witnesses. This was later determined to be false, as Adam Lanza was the only shooter.

At approximately 1213 hours SPTU West and East Personnel responded to and met at a staging location at the intersection of Yogananda Street and Bresson Farm Road in Newtown (approximately ¼ mile from the residence). Team members were informed that uniformed Newtown Police and Connecticut State Police had set up a perimeter

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around the residence. SPTU and ESU Bomb Squad personnel were briefed, and SPTU Sniper/Perimeter Teams were deployed around the Lanza residence at 36 Yogananda Street. A tactical plan was developed to have **13, 14**




Once completed, SPTU Personnel would enter and secure the dwelling.


At approximately 1230 hours all uniformed personnel were relieved from the perimeter and they were re-deployed to set-up a secured, outer perimeter on Yogananda Street while SPTU conducted Tactical Operations at the residence. At approximately 1235 hours the remaining SPTU Personnel moved to the residence using the RG-12 Armored Vehicle. The RG-12 was positioned in the neighbor's driveway located at 34 Yogananda Street, directly to the south of the Lanza residence. The Lanza residence at 36 Yogananda Street is a two story colonial style home with an attached two car garage. The house was pale yellow in color with dark green shutters (see attached maps).

At approximately 1239 hours SPTU West Personnel moved up to the residence and **13, 14**

Meanwhile, SPTU East Personnel and the sniper/perimeter teams held the perimeter in direct support of SPTU West Personnel. **13, 14**

At approximately 1251 hours, after SPTU West Personnel completed the breaching of doors to the residence, SPTU Personnel were advised that some additional people were found hiding within the Sandy Hook Elementary School Building. Captain Fusaro assigned SPTU West Personnel to return to Sandy Hook Elementary School and conduct another search of the building for additional people. SPTU West Personnel with the RG-12 departed the scene on Yogananda Street, while SPTU West Snipers and all SPTU East Personnel remained at 36 Yogananda Street to continue Tactical Operations. Captain Fusaro returned to Sandy Hook Elementary School with SPTU West Personnel, and Tactical Command at 36 Yogananda Street was turned over to Sergeant Palen, SPTU Deputy Commander-Operations.

[REDACTED] At approximately 1329 hours SPTU East Personnel entered the Lanza residence through the front door, searched and secured the first floor and garage area, to include a vehicle, a BMW color silver bearing Connecticut registration 593XGR, located within the garage of the residence. Nothing remarkable was located on the first floor or garage area.


At approximately 1339 hours the first floor had been secured, and SPTU East Personnel [REDACTED] 13, 14

[REDACTED] At approximately 1343 hours while on the second floor landing/hallway at the top of the stairs, SPTU East Personnel and I visually located what appeared to be a middle-aged white female lying supine on the bed in the master bedroom. A rifle was observed in plain view on the floor adjacent to the side of the bed. The female did not respond to verbal direction and she appeared to be deceased with Blood-Like Substance (BLS) on her head and the bedding material. We did not immediately approach the female due to concerns that hazards may be located within the residence as the second floor had not yet been cleared. At approximately 1346 hours I requested to have an ambulance and paramedics respond to the residence and stand-by pending the securing of the residence. [REDACTED] 13, 14

At approximately 1408 hours SPTU East Personnel re-entered the dwelling, cleared and secured the first floor and then the second floor. SPTU East Personnel entered the master bedroom on the second floor. There, we found a white female, later identified as Nancy Lanza, deceased and lying supine in bed. There was an obvious gunshot wound to the forehead area with BLS on her head and bedding material. There were no life signs present and it appeared that she had been deceased for at least several hours. She was wearing sleepwear and the bed sheets and blankets were pulled up to her chest. A rifle was located on the floor next to the side of the bed. The rifle appeared to be a .22 caliber rifle. There was one spent shell casing that I observed on the floor next to the rifle. It appeared that the female had been ambushed and killed while sleeping in bed. The remainder of the second floor and the attic were searched and secured. I escorted AMR Ambulance Paramedic Dennis Posila into the residence and to the second floor, master bedroom so the presumption of death could be made of the white female - Nancy Lanza. Paramedic Posila made the official presumption of death at approximately 1425 hours.

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SPTU East Personnel remained on the first floor, posted at the door that accesses the basement. 13, 14

At approximately 1433 hours SPTU East Personnel entered the basement by way of the bulkhead doors, cleared and secured the basement of the residence. A secondary search of the residence was conducted to ensure no other victims were located within the residence. The secondary search of the residence was completed at approximately 1459 hours. At this time the residence was deemed secure, and State Police Major Crime was requested to the scene.

During operations at 36 Yogananda Street, SPTU East Personnel noted that the lights and television were on in the neighboring residence at 34 Yogananda Street. Due to the circumstance and the proximity of this residence to the Lanza residence, there was concern that possible victims could be located within the residence as the residence was unlocked and a vehicle was in the driveway. I notified Sergeant Palen of this, and Sergeant Palen said that the family had been evacuated from their residence by uniform police personnel prior to our arrival on Yogananda Street. Due to safety concerns, SPTU EAST Personnel entered the front door of the residence located at 34 Yogananda Street and cleared and secured this residence as well. No one was found within this neighboring residence.


SPTU Personnel were instructed to collapse the perimeter, and were directed to return to the Sandy Hook Elementary School for further direction. Sergeant Palen, Sergeant Bartolotta and I remained outside and in front of the Lanza residence to maintain security of the residence pending the arrival and scene turnover to State Police Major Crime. I spoke by telephone to Sergeant Quilty of State Police Central District Major Crime while at the residence and related my observations of the scene located within the Lanza residence.

On 12/14/12 at approximately 1735 hours Sergeant John Turner #245 of State Police Eastern District Major Crime arrived at the Lanza residence 36 Yogananda Street Newtown. I briefed Sergeant Turner on SPTU actions at the residence and our plain view observations during the search of the residence, and then conducted a walk-through of scene within the residence. At 1755 hours the crime scene at the Lanza residence 36 Yogananda Street Newtown was turned over to Sergeant Turner and all remaining SPTU Personnel secured from the location and returned to Sandy Hook Elementary School 12 Dickenson Drive Newtown.

Below are additional observations of the Lanza residence at the time we conducted SPTU Tactical Operations and entered the residence. The residence was well maintained and in above average condition inside. The first floor



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and second floor were well maintained and very neat and orderly. Other than the doors that were mentioned as being breached by SPTU West Personnel, nothing on the first floor seemed out of ordinary. On the second floor the northeast bedroom (located next to the master bedroom) had more than one rifle case and at least two handgun cases on the floor. There was some clutter in this room as it looked like it was being utilized as storage. The southeast bedroom appeared to be Adam Lanza's bedroom. There was only a bed sheet on the bed and no blankets. The windows were blocked from outside light with what appeared to be heavy black plastic poly sheeting covering all windows in the bedroom. The southwest room had been converted to an office/study area. We found a personal/home computer tower with the internal hard drive removed with this hard drive heavily damaged. It was obvious that this had purposely been done. In the closet of this room was a metal floor standing gun safe with the door to the safe slightly opened. I noted at least one older rifle with a wooden stock inside this safe. A television and Xbox game console were noted in this room as well.
