INTERVIEW of JOHN JELTEMA, First Responder, Captain of Sandy Hook Volunteer Fire Company

ACTION TAKEN: On Saturday December 15, 2012 at approximately 1600 hours, Detective Andre Roy and I met with John M. Jeltema at the Sandy Hook Fire House located at 18-20 Riverside Road in Sandy Hook. The purpose of this meeting was to obtain a written statement from Jeltema regarding his actions as a first responder during the Sandy Hook shooting incident. Det. Roy and I were given the use of the Chief's office for the purpose of this interview.

In a verbal and later in a written statement, John Jeltema states, "My name is John M. Jeltema and I am a 11 yr member of the Sandy Hook Vol. Fire & Rescue Co. Inc. I hold the position of Captain. On Friday December 14, 2012 while at work I received a call that there was a shooting at 12 Dickenson Dr. I immediately drove to the Sandy Hook Vol. Fire & Rescue firehouse on Riverside Rd. Upon arriving in the rear I assisted removing a female victim from a CSP vehicle. The female had what appeared to be a gunshot wound to the finger and left leg. While placing the patient on the stretcher, SHVF&R was dispatched to respond to 12 Dickenson Dr. After transferring patient care to Newtown Ambulance, I proceeded to drive Rescue 444 with Chief Halstead, Lt Ryan Clark, EMS Captain Karin Halstead, and FF Pete Barresi. Upon arrival at the scene, I began to establish Primary Triage Zone. Upon creation of the triage zone me and my crew stood by for further patients. We never received any more patients. Myself and none of my crew entered the school at any time during the incident." Jeltema's written statement is attached to this report.
