On the above mentioned date and time this Detective spoke with [REDACTED] 04 on his cell phone [REDACTED] 03).

Among other things, [REDACTED] 04 provided the following information verbally:

[REDACTED] 04 knew Adam Lanza from 2007 to 2008 when they both attended Newtown High School and participated in the "Tech Club" together. [REDACTED] 04 knew Lanza to be a quiet kid, and somewhat anxious because of his facial expressions and his upright posture when he walked. [REDACTED] 04 did not witness any panic attacks or violent behavior from Lanza during his interactions with him. The only odd behavior [REDACTED] 04 witnessed was Lanza pulling his sleeves over his hands any time he was handed an object from someone. Lanza would wipe the object down with his sleeves before he would actually touch the object. [REDACTED] 04 remarked that Lanza was quiet and sociable as long as he was included in the conversation. [REDACTED] 04 did not have any additional information to provide to this Detective.

Detective Pinelli,

This is [REDACTED] 04, 03. My date of birth is [REDACTED] 03 and I can be reached at [REDACTED] 03

I knew Adam Lanza from 2007-2008 during [REDACTED] 04 of high school where I took a class and was involved in my local tech club with him. In this time he was a generally quiet kid and I would say he seemed overly anxious partly because of his facial expression and that he always seemed to walk very upright. I don't recall him ever having a panic attack or violent outbreak, at least that I ever noticed. He did have a notable compulsion in that if you handed him something he would pull his sleeve over his hand before he took it and then wipe it off quickly before he actually touched it, but I don't know if there was an underlying phobia. Other than that, he was quiet but he was sociable so long as you made him feel like he was included in the conversation.
