**ACTION TAKEN:**

On 02/22/13, I received the attached copy of the Memorandum of Interview completed by U.S. Postal Inspector Jason Bourdeau. Bourdeau was assigned to conduct an interview of Letter Carrier David Link. In the interview, Link indicated that on 12/13/12, he observed a white male at Sandy Hook Elementary School who he deemed to be suspicious. He indicated that the male was too old to be a student but didn't appear old enough to be a parent. According to the interview report, Link could neither confirm or deny that the party that he saw was Adam Lanza based on a photo which he viewed with the Postal Inspector (see attached form).

**CASE STATUS:**

This case remains ACTIVE pending further investigation.

## MEMORANDUM OF INTERVIEW

On December 15, 2012 Inspector Matthew Morrison and I interviewed David Link, Letter Carrier at the Newtown, Connecticut Post Office. Link is the letter carrier for the Sandy Hook Elementary School. Link stated the following in substance and in part:

On December 13, 2012, between 1330 and 1400 hrs, Link delivered mail to the Sandy Hook Elementary School. Link entered the school by the front door, explaining that he had to be "buzzed" in by school administration. Upon entering the vestibule area of the school, he noticed a person by the cafeteria and vestibule area, pacing and acting nervous and suspicious. The person was peering out the front windows of the school and seemed to stare at Link for an unusual period of time. The person did not fit the type of individual you would see at the school, because he was too old to be a student and too young to be a teacher.

Link described the person as a white male, with wavy, dark colored hair between the ages of 16 and 20 years, with a thin build, approximately 5'7-5'8 tall. The person was wearing dark colored clothing and a plaid backpack.

On the day of the shooting incident at the school, Link provided the above mentioned information to an unidentified police officer that was directing traffic in Newtown.

Link has not seen a photo of Adam Lanza. Link was shown a photo of Adam Lanza, which was obtained via the Internet and depicted Lanza at a younger age. Link could not confirm or deny if this was the person at the school, noting that the photo looked too young.

I advised Link to contact me if he recalled any other information.
