ACTION TAKEN:

On 02/22/13, I received the attached copy of the Memorandum of Interview completed by U.S. Postal Inspector Jason Bourdeau. Bourdeau was assigned to conduct an interview of Letter Carrier Bertha Tientini. In the interview, Tientini indicated that she has been delivering mail to the Lanza residence at 36 Yogananda Street for approximately 6 years. She recalls having numerous pleasant interactions with Nancy throughout the time. She stated that on several occassions she recalls seeing a thin male, 18-20 years old, retrieving garbage cans from the top of the driveway. She stated that she assumes that the male was Adam Lanza but she had no interactions with him (see attached form).

CASE STATUS:

This case remains ACTIVE pending further investigation.

On December 15, 2012 I interviewed Bertha Tientini, Letter Carrier for the Newtown Post Office. Tientini stated the following in substance and in part:

Tientini has been delivering mail to 36 Yogananda Street, Newtown, Connecticut for approximately six years. In that time, she has had numerous interactions with one of the residents, Nancy Lanza, all of which have been pleasant and cordial in nature. Lanza was an attractive woman who maintained her appearance.

Lanza received numerous packages from high end retailers along with catalogues. Lanza never complained or appeared agitated. Besides delivering mail, Tientini had no other interactions with Lanza.

On several occasions Tientini observed a male, between 18-20 years of age with a thin build retrieving garbage cans from the top of the driveway. Tientini assumed that this person was Lanza's son. Tientini had no interactions with this individual.

Tientini could not recall hearing arguing or fighting at the residence.

The residence was described as well maintained with a long driveway, in an exclusive neighborhood.

Tientini was instructed to turn over all mail going to the residence to her supervisor, until further notice.
