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On 04/11/13 at approximately 0940 hours, I called Robert Anthony's hair salon on Church Hill Rd, in Newtown, CT regarding information that we received that Adam Lanza was a customer there. I spoke with Diane Skuba (daughter), co-owner, who informed me that Nancy was never a customer and that Adam Lanza was a customer. Skuba stated that Jackie Davis was Lanza's hairdresser and that she no longer worked there. Skuba stated that Bob sometimes cut his hair but not often. When asked how we would be able to contact Davis, Skuba stated that she is approximately 30 years old and lives [REDACTED] 03. Skuba also stated that when CNN came to their salon, she stated that things got misconstrued and that what was printed in the newspapers about Adam Lanza was not what they (members of the salon) said.

Detective Downs #502 was able to locate a Jacquelyn Davis in [REDACTED] 03 through a law enforcement database. A business card was left at the home of her parents, asking Davis to contact me in which she did.

On 04/25/13, at approximately 1615 hours, Detective Mudry #824 and I met with Jacquelyn Davis, DOB [REDACTED] 03, at the State Police Barracks, Troop A, Southbury, CT with regards to the ongoing investigation. Jacquelyn Davis was the primary hairdresser for Ryan and Adam Lanza. During the interview, Davis stated, in part, the following:

That she has been a hairdresser for 11 years and was employed by Robert Anthony's Salon in Newtown for approximately 9 years. During that time, she was the primary hairdresser for both Ryan and Adam Lanza. Davis stated that during the later part of her employment, Adam had gone to other stylists at Robert Anthony's. Davis stated that Ryan was approximately 16 years old when he started coming to her and he was a customer until he moved away after graduation of college. Davis stated that she saw Ryan socially as they had the same interests in music bands and she stated that he was a nice, sweet, intelligent shy guy.

Davis stated that Adam was around 14-15 years old or middle school to high school age when she started to cut his hair. Davis stated that when she first met Adam, she was told by his mother, Nancy Lanza, that he had autism and did not want to be touched. Davis stated that she was told not to shampoo his hair, just spray it down, which meant make it wet with a spray bottle. Davis also stated that she was always told by Nancy to take an inch to 1/2 inch off and leave the bangs a certain length, more in his face. Davis stated that when she cut Adam's hair, he did not like to be touched. The sound of the clippers would cause him to cower away and she would hardly use them. He sat with his hands in his lap and would always look down, never at her. Davis stated that she was told, either by Nancy or Ryan, that Adam was very intelligent and therefore she would just talk to him normal. Davis stated that she would have a conversation with him but he would never return it with anything other than one word answers. The answer would be in a soft whisper, not a completed word, but enough that she could understand what he would say. Davis stated that when Adam

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answered, he would always move his head in a downward direction. Davis stated that when she cut his hair, he usually came with his mother and she would stay in the front lobby and not hang around near him. Davis stated that when Adam was done with his haircut, he would get up from the chair, walk to the lobby, and standby by the door and wait for his mother as if he could not wait to go.

Davis stated that when Adam came in, he would usually be wearing tan khaki pants, and a white collared shirt, short or long sleeved. The shirts were always oversized. Davis stated that she never saw him wearing any black clothing of any sort.

Davis stated that to the best of her recollection, Ryan never mentioned anything to her about his brother, Adam, and she does not ever remember seeing them talk when they were together. Davis stated that the boys usually came to the salon separately and Nancy was not a customer there.

Davis stated that she left the salon in the summer of 2011 and went to work for Salon Michele in Newtown, which is next to My Place restaurant and bar. Davis stated that was the last time that she saw Adam (summer 2011). Davis stated that she and her co-workers would go to My Place once a week, most often on different nights, after the salon closed between 8-9 PM and she would always see Nancy there at the bar until 11 or 12 PM. Davis stated that Nancy would hang out there with the same group of people and that same group still hangs out there today. Davis stated that sometimes she would ask Nancy about Ryan and Adam and Nancy would only tell Davis what Ryan was doing and would rarely speak of Adam. Davis stated that Nancy had a dry sense of humor, was direct, not mean, and not a "huggy" person. Davis stated that others would perceive her as snooty. Davis stated that she liked Nancy. Davis stated that when Nancy had a few drinks at My Place and she would see Davis, Nancy would get huggy with Davis.

Davis verbally stated to us that the stories that were printed from the interview with Bob Skuba, co-owner of Robert Anthony's, were not true.

See attached written statement prepared and notarized by this Detective, witnessed by Detective Mudry, and sworn to and signed by Davis.

CASE STATUS: This case will remain active pending further investigation.
