ACTION TAKEN:

On 07/11/13, I was assigned to review Investigative Reports received from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF). ATF Report #8 documents an interview of [REDACTED] 30. According to the report, Nancy Lanza sold a Ruger Mini-14 Ranch Rifle, bearing serial number 187-95017, to [REDACTED] 30 (now known as [REDACTED] 30) in [REDACTED] 30, FL on 3/24/11. [REDACTED] 30 is the responsible party on the FFL for [REDACTED] 30. According to the Acquisition and Disposition (A & D) Log Book maintained by [REDACTED] 30 the Ruger was purchased from Lanza on "3/24/12" and subsequently sold to [REDACTED] on "3/24/11". The ATF Agents noticed a discrepancy in the year of purchase and sale. (See attached ATF Report #8)



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SUMMARY OF EVENT:

On December 18, 2012, SA 30 and IOI 30 went to 30 to interview 30 (responsible person on the FFL) regarding a rifle that was sold to 30 by Nancy Lanza.

NARRATIVE:

1. On December 18, 2012, SA 30 received a collateral request from the Boston Field Division to interview 30 to confirm that a Ruger Mini-14 Ranch rifle was sold to the FFL.
2. SA 30 and IOI 30 went to 30 formerly 30, located at 30, FL, to speak to 30. 30 did not recall the transaction, however, she searched her records and provided a copy of the Acquisition and Disposition Log Book (A & D) pages that contain an entry dated "3/24/12" indicating the acquisition of the Ruger Mini-14, .223 caliber rifle bearing serial number 187-95017. The A & D record also indicates that on 3/24/11, the rifle was transferred to 30. 30 provided a copy of the ATF F 4473 which indicates that the firearm was transferred on 3/31/11. She stated that the purchaser is a regular customer. It should be noted that after the records were obtained, IOI 30. While 30 was searching the records, SA 30 asked an employee about the name change of the business and he stated that when 30 he kept the business but changed the name and obtained a new FFL. 3. 30 provided SA 30 with copies of the pages from the A & D book that contain the entries pertaining to the firearm bought from Ms. Lanza. She also provided a copy of Ms. Lanza's driver's license and the ATF F 4473 that reveals who bought the firearms from 30.
4. SA 30 asked 30 to search all records to determine if there were any other transactions that were
