INTERVIEW REPORT- 04

SUBJECT: 03 04

DATE AND TIME: On 10/16/13 from approximately 0910 hours to approximately 0945 hours.

LOCATION: This interview was conducted in the Adult Probation Office located at 319 Main St. in Danbury, CT.

**ACTION TAKEN:**

On 08/16/13, I was assigned to review documents returned from the FBI-Behavioral Analysis Unit. A review of box #3 of 5 boxes revealed a spiral bound booklet called "The Big Book of Granny", which appeared to be created by the shooter and 04. The book is bound in a black plastic spiral binding and covered on the front and back with a clear plastic sheeting.

On 10/16/13 at approximately 0900 hours, Det. Van Ness and I met at the office of 04 Probation Officer, Henry Wardowski, at 319 Main St. in Danbury, CT. Wardowski stated that he was recently assigned to supervise 04 stemming from a court case involving motor vehicle charges.

THAT THE REPORT IS AN ACCURATE STATEMENT OF THE INFORMATION SO RECEIVED BY ME.

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Wardowski stated that [04] is currently residing in a group home under constant supervision. Upon arrival to the Probation Department, [04] was escorted to the office by P.O. Wardowski. [04] agreed to speak to us about his knowledge of the shooter and the creation of "The Big Book of Granny." [04] indicated that he was in class with the shooter in [04] grade and remembers him in [04] grade as well at [04]. He stated that he didn't recall seeing the shooter in [04] grade but recalls seeing him again in [04] grade at [04]. [04] stated that he transferred to [04] [04] stated that he remembered the shooter being [04] when [04] described the shooter as a "weird" kid. When asked why he found him to be "weird", [04] stated that he was someone who would sit by himself on the other side of the room and would not talk or associate with anybody else. [04] stated that he also thought it was weird that the shooter would come to school with a briefcase, instead of a backpack like everyone else. [04] stated that despite the fact that [04] he never played with or associated with the shooter outside of school. He stated that he had never been to the shooter's house and the shooter had never been to his house. He stated that he has not seen the shooter since [04].

[04] stated that "The Big Book of Granny" was created as an assignment in [04] grade class. [04] stated that the class was divided up into groups and told to create a comic-style book. [04] stated that he didn't recall who else was in the group with him and the shooter, but did recall that there were others in the group. He stated that the group had agreed to do their comic book in a "Calvin and Hobbes" style. He stated that everyone in the group would come up with ideas or jokes and write them down and then present them to the shooter to be included in the comic book. [04] stated that he was responsible for the illustrations, but only recalls one picture. He stated that was a picture of "Granny" holding her cane up like a gun with one hand. He stated that he doesn't recall any additional pictures that were included in the comic book. [04] stated that he doesn't recall who created the final copy or how many copies were made, but he thought that his mother may have a copy. He stated that he believed that the school was responsible for binding and covering the book before submission. [04] stated that he believed that "The Big Book of Granny" was submitted to be graded for the assignment.

[04] had no additional information to contribute to this investigation. This interview was concluded at approximately 0945 hours.

CASE STATUS:

This case remains ACTIVE pending further investigation.
