Interviewee:

Eugene Rosen, D.O.B. 03

Interview: On 12/15/12, this Detective and Detective Downs #502, responded to 03, and met with Eugene Rosen, D.O.B. 03, of the aforementioned address, with regards to the ongoing investigation. During the interview, Rosen stated, in part, the following:

That on 12/14/12, at approximately 0930 hours, he was exiting the loft of a detached building on his property when he observed several, perhaps 6 as he recalls, small children to be sitting in the grass out by the fence at the edge of his property. Rosen stated that there was a tall man standing near the children, telling them that it was going to be okay. Rosen recalled that the man seemed agitated, and that he doesn't recall where the male went or when he left, but that he didn't see the male again after he, Rosen, made contact with the children. Rosen stated that there was a female bus driver named 04 LNU with the children at the time. Rosen clarified that 04 told him that she had "picked them (the children) up," but stated that he did not know from where or how she had come to have the children with her. Rosen stated that he and 04 brought the children inside his house and tried to calm them down. Rosen stated that the children were crying and saying that they couldn't go back to school because they didn't have a teacher and that their teacher was dead. Rosen stated that after having seen the news footage overnight, he believes that the details that the children were relaying were those pertaining to the shooting death of Victoria Soto. Rosen stated that he and 04 tried to call a few of the telephone numbers that some of the children verbally gave them to contact their parents, but that he believed that many were home telephone

numbers and he wasn't able to reach anyone. Rosen stated that [04] called her supervisor at the bus company and gave the supervisor the names of the children present, and stated that the supervisor was able to contact at least some of the parents, some of whom began arriving at Rosen's house within 10 to 15 minutes later to collect their children. Rosen stated that there were still a few children left at his house, perhaps two to the best of his recollection, when he and [04] brought the children next door to the firehouse. Rosen could not recall how they had gotten word that the children were all being brought there, but knew that it had come from some outside source. Rosen stated that once they got to the firehouse, they saw that the police and the faculty and staff were there taking attendance and he turned the two children over to them. Rosen stated that he gave his contact information and anything else he thought would be useful, including the telephone numbers he had tried calling, to one of the Troopers at the firehouse before leaving.

When asked what details he had overheard or been told by the children, Rosen stated that he had heard several of the boys in the group talking about the guns the shooter had, one boy had said he saw the man with a big gun and then another boy stated that he had seen the man with a little gun. Rosen stated that he recalled that the boys may have settled on the idea that the man had two guns on him, both a big one and a little one. Additionally, Rosen stated that one of the little girls had relayed to him that their teacher, Ms. Soto [03, 12]

The status of the case remains actively under investigation.
