numbers and he wasn't able to reach anyone. Rosen stated that 04 called her supervisor at the bus company and gave the supervisor the names of the children present, and stated that the supervisor was able to contact at least some of the parents, some of whom began arriving at Rosen's house within 10 to 15 minutes later to collect their children. Rosen stated that there were still a few children left at his house, perhaps two to the best of his recollection, when he and 04 brought the children next door to the firehouse. Rosen could not recall how they had gotten word that the children were all being brought there, but knew that it had come from some outside source. Rosen stated that once they got to the firehouse, they saw that the police and the faculty and staff were there taking attendance and he turned the two children over to them. Rosen stated that he gave his contact information and anything else he thought would be useful, including the telephone numbers he had tried calling, to one of the Troopers at the firehouse before leaving.

When asked what details he had overheard or been told by the children, Rosen stated that he had heard several of the boys in the group talking	
about the guns the shooter had, one boy had said he saw the man with a big gun and then another boy stated that he had seen the man with a litt	le
gun. Rosen stated that he recalled that the boys may have settled on the idea that the man had two guns on him, both a big one and a little one.
