The Forensic Lab compared a known blood sample taken from Nancy Lanza and a known liver sample taken from Adam Lanza during the autopsies. The report concluded that Nancy Lanza was the biological mother of Adam Lanza. See attached report.

# RESULTS OF EXAMINATION:

- 1. DNA was extracted from item #13-S2 and submission #14. DNA was purified according to standard laboratory protocols.
- 2A. Extracted material obtained from item #13-S2 and submission #14 was amplified by the AmpF/STR Identifiler procedure as described in laboratory protocols. STR alleles were separated and detected by standard laboratory protocols.

3. Item #13-S2 was consumed in testing. Submission #14 was returned to the submitting agency.

### **CONCLUSIONS:**

4. The results are consistent with Nancy Lanza (item #13-S2) being the mother of "Adam Lanza" (submission #14). The expected frequency of females who could be the mother of "Adam Lanza" is approximately 1 in 530,000 in the African American population, approximately 1 in 37,000 in the Caucasian population, and approximately 1 in 53,000 in the Hispanic population.
