On December 14, 2012, in response to the Sandy Hook Elementary School shooting and at the request of the Connecticut State Police, the Hoboken, New Jersey Police Department responded to #1313 Grand Street, Apartment 202, Hoboken, New Jersey, the home of Ryan Lanza. Initial details of the shooting identified Ryan Lanza as the possible perpetrator deceased at the scene – however Hoboken Police Department located Ryan Lanza at his address and the perpetrator was subsequently identified as Ryan's brother, Adam Lanza of Newtown, CT.

For details of the Hoboken Police response see attached Hoboken Police Department reports filed under Blotter # CH-063484-12 and Case # CH-03669-12.

On 08/07/13 at approximately 1445 hours this writer spoke with Detective Sergeant Anthony Falco Jr. of the Hoboken Police Department (201-420-2100, 2110), in an effort to verify that the copies of the Hoboken Police Department reports that had been provided to the FBI and the Connecticut State Police were in fact a complete copy of all Hoboken reports related to this incident. Sergeant Falco confirmed that all reports in possession of the Connecticut State Police were in fact a true and complete representation of the Hoboken Police Department case file and may be copied as needed.

just shot multiple people at the school. He said that the actor lived at 1313 Grand Street Hoboken NJ apartment 202. We went to that location to secure the perimeter of the building along with the apartment. Once we arrived at the apartment door Sergeant Labruno knocked to see if anyone was home and no one answered the door.

Captain Fitzsimmons was notified by Lt Cruz and he responded to our location. Once he arrived Captain Fitzsimmons and Lt Cruz left the scene and went downstairs to speak to management of the building. I along with Sergeant Labruno stayed behind to make sure no one enters or leaves the apartment. Captain Fitzsimmons, Jersey City Bomb squad and the Federal Bureau of Investigations arrived on scene. The Bomb squad and Federal Bureau of Investigations checked the apartment door and then went downstairs.

I along with Sergeant Labruno heard a noise coming from an apartment. A female (██████████ 04 ██████████) opened apartment 202 door Mr Ryan Lanza's apartment. Sergeant Labruno asked her why when we knocked on your door you did not open it. She said that she thought it was the Fedx delivery man. At that time Sergeant Labruno called Lt Cruz and told him that the female ██████████ 04 just opened the door to the apartment.

It was then, Patrolman Edward Lepre and myself noticed a male walking on the East Side of Grand Street, the same side of 1313 Grand Street. He was approximately 200 feet from our location. License in his back pocket and a cell phone in his front pocket. He said he just left his place of employment, Ernst and Young, 5 Times Square, New York. He began to cry and stated that his brother, Adam Peter Lanza, 04-22-1992, is the shooter and also killed his mother, Nancy Jean Lanza, at their home that they shared, 36 Yogananda Street, Sandy Hook, Connecticut, 06482. Sandy Hook, Connecticut, 06482. P.O. Burke asked Lanza how he knew this, and he said he was notified by his father Peter John Lanza and it was all over Facebook. He also informed us that he received several phone calls to his cellphone (as well as text messages) about the incident. He was detained and placed in my patrol vehicle, vehicle #123.

P.O. Burke sat next to Lanza in the back of my patrol vehicle and asked about his two roommates. Lanza informed us that his roommate, [REDACTED] 04, was home (in the apartment) and he can call her on his cell phone, which P.O. Burke had in his possession, which was ringing constantly. P.O. Burke asked Lanza if [REDACTED] 04 was home, and he said "Yes", and her boyfriend, [REDACTED] 04, was in California. Hoboken Police Officers and the F.B.I. made their way up to the apartment. At that time, Sgt. La Bruno (who was posted at the apartment door for the last 2 and 1/2 hours) informed Lt. Cruz, via cell phone, that the apartment door was opened by [REDACTED] 04 and she appeared to be in good health. Sgt. La Bruno informed me that he asked [REDACTED] 04 if she heard the police knocking on the apartment door for the last two hours (knocked on the door approximately ever 15 minutes) and she stated to him, "I thought it was Fed-Ex". She informed him that's why she didn't answer the door. Capt. Fitzsimmons and the F.B.I. were now speaking to [REDACTED] 04 from the building's hallway while [REDACTED] 04 was still inside the apartment. She informed Capt. Fitzsimmons that her boyfriend and roommate, [REDACTED] 04, was in California. Then [REDACTED] 04 allowed Capt. Fitzsimmons and the F.B.I. in her apartment.

time line of movement was set. The following members of the Federal Bureau of Investigations; Special's Agent Sean Lynch, John Mulligan, Todd Bina, and TFO Detective Sergeant Vic Monata (Newark PD) were tasked out on scene to perform specific duties. I, along with Special Agent Sean Lynch, Captain Fitzsimmons, Lieutenant Kevin Cruz, members of the Jersey City Bomb Squad, responded to apartment #202 in an attempt to gain entry and conduct a public safety search of the apartment for any weapons, explosive devices, or a potential victim.

While responding to apartment #202 we were informed by Sergeant Christopher Labruno that a [REDACTED] 04 (roommate) has opened the door to that apartment. Once directly in front of the apartment [REDACTED] 04 granted verbal consent to enter the apartment to conduct a public safety search. We quickly maneuvered through the apartment and did not observe any potential threats or injured person's.

At this time I exited the building and waited for further direction. While outside I was met by Detective Sergeant Anthony Falco who directed me to return to police headquarters to assist with the interviews of Ryan Lanza and [REDACTED] 04. Once in the Detective Bureau I, along with Detective Sergeant Anthony Falco were redirected to respond back to the apartment complex (apartment #202) to conduct a search of the apartment for any potential physical evidence which could be linked to this investigation. Prior to responding to the apartment Mr. Ryan Lanza and [REDACTED] 04 signed consent to search forms granting us permission to conduct a search of the apartment.

We responded to the building and met with Special Agents White and Mack of the Federal Bureau of Investigations (Bomb Technicians), and three members of the Jersey City Bomb Squad. I, along with Detective Sergeant Anthony Falco and the above mentioned personnel entered the apartment and conducted a search with negative results. We exited the apartment building and returned to the Detective Bureau and continued to assist with the investigation.

Additional reports regarding the investigation will be generated by Special Agent Sean Lynch of the Federal Bureau of Investigations.

I began to ask him questions about if he knew the residents in apartment # 202 and if so was there anyway he could get as much information about them as possible. Mr. Hernandez then did get on the phone and called Cheryl who worked in the leasing office of the building which was located at 101 Marshall Street, Hoboken NJ 07030. Within a few minutes Mr. Hernandez, did supply us with the information of three people who were on the lease for that particular apartment. possession a key for the apartment as well. I then took possession of the key. At no time did I or any other officer use this key to enter the apartment. At this time Lieutenant Cruz told me that Officer Lulaj and I would be posted in the hallway to keep a visual surveillance of apartment # 202.

Approximately two hours later while Officer Lulaj and I were standing in the hallway the apartment door # 202 opened and woman had started to exit the door. At this point we did go and speak to the woman who was later identified as " [REDACTED] 04 ". While talking to her , I called Lieutenant Cruz and notified him of what had just occurred . After hanging up the phone I asked [REDACTED] 04 if she was ok to which she responded , "yes". As I was about to ask another question Captain James Fitzsimmons, Lieutenant Kevin Cruz, along with other F.B.I. agents had just come off the elevator and were approaching the apartment door that I was standing in front. Captain Fitzsimmons along with F.B.I. agents began to talk to [REDACTED] 04 and I was no longer involved in any conversations at the apartment. I was then reassigned to another post in front of the 1313 Grand Street, building to keep the media orderly until 1715 hours where then I was properly relieved by Lieutenant John Miskulin . Prior to leaving 1313 Grand Street I handed off the apartment#202 key to F.B.I. agent Chris White.

Today is Tuesday December 18, 2012, I am currently assigned to the Detective Bureau working the 0701-1501hrs. tour of duty.							
On Friday December 14, 2012, at approximately 1420hrs., I responded to 1313 Grand St. to further assist with this investigation. Upon arrival I met with Captain James Fitzsimmons and began to coordinate efforts with him, in an attempt to further investigate this incident as thoroughly and efficiently as possible. Captain Fitzsimmons advised me that P.O. Nicholas Burke had located and briefly spoke with Mr. Ryan Lanza. Through this brief interview it was believed that the individual responsible for the incident in Connecticut was Mr. Ryan Lanza's younger brother, Adam Lanza. I also spoke with Detective Michael DePalma who advised me that he, along with other law enforcement personnel at the scene, were granted access into apartment #202 by Mr. Ryan Lanza's roommate, 04. They then conducted a cursory search to ensure that nobody was injured within the apartment and may have needed medical assistance. This search was initially being conducted as a precautionary measure to ensure public safety, but sometime prior to the entry Lt. Diaz of the Hudson County Prosecutor's Office Homicide Squad advised us that he had received information about Mr. Peter Lanza, Ryan and Adams biological father, as being deceased within apartment #202. This information apparently proved to be false. I immediately contacted Lt. Diaz and informed him that nobody was found

injured or deceased within apartment #202, nor was there any evidence which would suggest that there ever was. He advised me that he was now going to contact Hudson County Prosecutor Guy Gregory and advise him of the outcome of our search, due to the fact that Prosecutor Gregory had provided Lt. Diaz with this information and gave him an order to follow up on it with the Hoboken Police Department. After this conversation was complete, I then advised Detective DePalma, and all other Detective personnel on scene, to transport Mr. Ryan Lanza and [REDACTED] 04 to the Hoboken Police Department Detective Bureau to ensure their safety and to also conduct a more thorough interview, in an attempt to ascertain if they have any additional pertinent information which may need to be relayed to the Connecticut State Police. I then briefly spoke with Captain Fitzimmons to keep him abreast of what was being conducted by Detective Bureau personnel. I then responded to the Detective Bureau. While here I advised several Detective's to assist personnel from the Federal Bureau of Investigations in any way needed. Also, Mr. Ryan Lanza and [REDACTED] 04 provided Consent to Search forms, which were generated by P.O. Nicholas Burke. After doing so, FBI personnel, along with Hoboken Detective Personnel began conducting interviews and Detective Michael DePalma and I responded back to 1313 Grand St. Apt. #202 for the purpose of conducting a more thorough search. We then entered apartment #202 along with Special Agents Mack and White, but were also assisted by three personnel from the Jersey City Police Department Bomb Squad. Upon completing the search, it was determined that there was no visible evidence within the apartment which linked Mr. Lanza or [REDACTED] 04 to this incident. I was also advised by Special Agent Mack that they were awaiting orders from their supervisor and may be confiscating several computers from apartment #202 at a later time to be forensically analyzed at the FBI Forensic Laboratory in Quantico Virginia. Detective DePalma and I then responded back to the Detective Bureau.

During the next several hours, both Mr. Lanza and [REDACTED] 04 where interviewed and their cellular phones were forensically analyzed by FBI forensic technicians. A review of Mr. Lanza's credit card activity was also conducted. During this time Mr. Peter Lanza (Father) responded to the Detective Bureau, along with his current wife. [REDACTED] 04 parents also responded to the Detective Bureau.

During this time, approximately 20 members of various media outlets had gathered around Hoboken Police Headquarters. At approximately 2010hrs. I escorted [REDACTED] 04 to his vehicle and we drove it to the back area of Hoboken Police Headquarters (Court Street). Special Agent Sean Lynch and I, along with other Special Agents, then escorted [REDACTED] 04 and her mother into [REDACTED] 04 awaiting vehicle, while attempting to shield them from the swarming media. At approximately 2130hrs. I drove Mr. Peter Lanza's vehicle toward the back area of Hoboken Police Headquarters. Several members of the media swarmed the vehicle, at which point Special Agent Lynch and other Special Agents escorted Mr. Ryan Lanza, along with

<b>Narrative:</b>									
Today is Tuesday, December 18, 2012. I am currently assigned as Commander of the Uniformed Patrol Bureau.									
On Friday, December 14, 2012, at approximately 1130 hours, I was made aware of information received, via telephone, by Hoboken police headquarters, regarding a mass casualty shooting, at the Sandy Hook Elementary School in Newtown, Connecticut. The information reported by Connecticut law enforcement personnel was that the actor was alleged to be, one, Ryan Lanza of 1313 Grand Street, in the City of Hoboken, N.J. (note: a near simultaneous second phone call from Connecticut law enforcement, to Hoboken Police, corroborated the original information). Hoboken police dispatcher Feliciano Santos relayed the information to Uniformed Patrol Bureau personnel.									
Lieutenant Kevin Cruz was first to respond to the Hoboken location, along with Sergeant Christopher LaBruno and Officer Nikola Lulaj. I responded, shortly thereafter, accompanied by Officer Edward Lepre. We met the first responding officers at 1313 Grand Street, on the second floor, north of the alleged resident/actor's apartment #202. Lieutenant Cruz had already issued an order against any forced entry to the apartment #202 (note: the order remained in effect through the entire course of the incident). Building maintenance was contacted and provided information that included

the location of the building management company, located within in the southwest area of the city. Sergeant LaBruno and Officer Lulaj set up a visual surveillance of the actor's apartment from the north side corridor.

Lieutenant Cruz, Officer Lepre and I temporarily exited the building and set up incident command on the opposite side of the roadway, outside of the alleged actor's residence, where we began to develop a plan of action. We were already in possession of a driver's license photo copy of the alleged actor, Ryan Lanza. Lieutenant Cruz reported that he was in contact, via cell phone with Connecticut State Police who were now established as the overall unified incident commander at the Newtown, Connecticut school. As the event was still unfolding, not much substantiated information could be obtained at that time. It should be noted that unconfirmed information began to saturate media channels.

They included reports that varying numbers of elementary school students were killed during the shooting; the actor/ shooter was shot and killed at the Connecticut elementary school; there may be accomplices or a second shooter (who remains at-large); the actor's mother was shot and killed at the school, and later; the actor/ shooter's father was shot and killed in his New Jersey home. Although there were no reports, at the time, that explosives or other incendiary devices were used in the attack, precautionary consideration was given to that possibility, based on prior incidents (eg. the recent Aurora, Colorado shooting -booby trap- incident). Those considerations led to contacting, and requesting the placing ON STANDBY the Jersey City Emergency Services/ Bomb Squad Unit, while we awaited credible updates from law enforcement personnel in Connecticut.

Officer Edward Lepre was ordered to respond to the building management company to obtain lease agreement information and any other information that could more thoroughly identify the alleged actor/ shooter and the identities of what had been reported as his possible roommates. Officer Lepre would report to the Detective Bureau with whatever information he obtained from building management. The Detective Bureau, Sergeant Anthony Falco, Jr., was contacted and made aware of Officer Lepre's duties and prepared to further our investigative efforts. Any and all additional information would be subsequently returned by Officer Lepre to Incident Command at 13th and Grand Streets.

Through the communications center, at Hoboken police headquarters, personnel were advised to minimize any police radio communication connected to the Grand Street address. Most communication between Incident Command, surveillance officers and police headquarters was completed via officer's cell phones. While the Newtown, Connecticut tragedy was now national news, there were no media/ journalists or curious onlookers visibly interested in the area around 1313 Grand Street.

I had been in contact with Chief Anthony Falco, Sr., keeping him advised of these early events as information continued to develop. I remained in contact with him throughout the course of the day and evening hours. The Incident Command/ Operation increased and other Hoboken police officers assumed integral parts in the continued operation. Among them were Detective Michael DePalma; Detective William Collins and Officer Nicholas Burke. I was advised that members of the Federal Bureau of Investigation had contacted Detective DePalma and were en route to the incident location on Grand Street. Special Agent Sean Lynch arrived on scene. He was accompanied by Special Agents John Mulligan, Victor Manata and Todd Bina. With each such similar development, Chief Falco was contacted and advised of our status at the scene. The Hoboken Police Department also contacted the Hudson County Prosecutor's Office and the New Jersey State Police. The Hoboken Volunteer Ambulance Corp was contacted and responded to the perimeter area between Grand and Adam on 13th Streets with ambulances, EMT's and trained HVAC volunteers, where they staged, in the event the need for emergency first-aid arose.

Although we had not yet heard any credible intelligence concerning "explosives" or "booby trapping" in connection with the alleged actor or his Grand Street apartment, I ordered and participated in a survey of the interior upper and lower floors in the Grand Street apartment complex. Additional manpower were called to the scene. Lieutenant Kevin Cruz was ordered to formulate a plan for the quiet evacuation of the upper and lower floors located on the south side of the complex [south of the elevator shaft]. Although a preliminary plan was formulated, the evacuation was never carried out.

As the day continued, other rumored information circulated news and social media venues. Members of the news media began to gather in the area. Yellow caution tape was placed across each intersection on three sides of the building identified herein as Grand Street at 13th Street, Grand Street at 14th Street and 13th Street at Clinton Street, to prohibit access to the building complex at 1313 Grand Street, by media and/ or other unauthorized personnel.

At about 1430 hours, the alleged actor, Ryan Lanza was observed, by Officer Nicholas Burke and Officer Edward Lepre, walking south on Grand Street from 14th Street toward the apartment complex at 1313 Grand Street. It is reported that the alleged actor, Ryan Lanza was ordered to stop, raise his arms above his head and show his hands. It is reported that he dropped to his knees and shouted that he didn't want officers to shoot him; that he didn't kill anyone; that it was his brother, Adam, who had committed the murders and; that his brother, Adam, had killed their mother. In the interest of the public's safety and the safety of police officers, on the scene, Ryan Lanza was placed in handcuffs and in custody of the Hoboken Police Department. He continued to ramble excitedly that he hadn't killed anyone; that he was just coming home from work; that [REDACTED] 04 (a roommate) was upstairs in their apartment and knew he was coming home and; that his

father had called him earlier in the day. He repeated his comments about his brother, Adam, being the person who had also killed his mother.

Shortly thereafter, I received information that a female identified as [REDACTED] 04 (a roommate) had opened the door of apartment #202. It was reported that after looking out into the hallway/ corridor and observing officers she remained at her position. I immediately grabbed hold of Hoboken Lieutenant Kevin Cruz, a Special Agent (FBI) and a Jersey City Police Department bomb technician and proceeded to the second floor, via elevator, and then to [REDACTED] 04 who stood in the doorway/ entrance to their apartment #202. I spoke with her, briefly, and was subsequently granted access into the apartment with accompanying law enforcement personnel to conduct a cursory search of the apartment for any seriously injured persons. The search for possible victims or seriously injured persons proved to be negative. [REDACTED] 04 was asked if she would accompany us to police headquarters where we could further speak with her. She commented that she would come to police headquarters but also stated that her mother was on her way to meet her at the Grand Street apartment. She was told that she could call her mother, via her cell phone, and then ask her mother to meet up with [REDACTED] 04 at police headquarters. She agreed and immediately prepared to leave the apartment. Transportation of the alleged actor/ shooter, Ryan Lanza and [REDACTED] 04 (a roommate) and the transition of command was discussed with Sergeant Anthony Falco, Jr. Both Ryan and [REDACTED] 04 were transported to the Hoboken Police Department's Detective Bureau for further investigation.

Except for a continued role as uniformed patrol bureau support to detective bureau personnel, the investigation was handed off to the Detective Bureau in cooperation Special Agents from the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
