Supplemental Report

ACTION TAKEN: On 12-14-12, the Newtown Police Department, along with Troopers from the Connecticut State Police responded to a school shooting at the Sandy Hook Elementary School in Newtown.



At approximately 0930 hrs I was contacted by Sergeant R. Palen #270 who reported that he was notified of a school shooting in Newtown, CT. He informed me that he and several other members of the State Police Tactical Unit were responding from Hartford. I indicated that I would meet him there and I began to respond from my residence.


After arriving on scene at the Sandy Hook Elementary School, I assumed tactical command as SPTU personnel continued to clear the school of any potential threats. Personnel from various agencies, to include the Federal Bureau of Investigation's New Haven Field Office were also on scene.

SGT Palen, who arrived prior to me, informed me that there were multiple victims. West Team Leader TFC J. Voket #1096 met me in the entry way of the school and briefed me on what had apparently transpired and that STPU personnel, along with FBI-NH SWAT were continuing to conduct a secondary sweep of the school. I made several observations of the scene while operations continued.

I then met with TFC Voket who informed that both primary and secondary sweeps of the school were completed. He indicated that the school appeared secure and that they were unable to locate any other suspects, however one possible suspect (later identified as Adam LANZA) was deceased in one of the classrooms.

After meeting with TFC Voket inside the school, I approached the main entrance where I met with Lieutenant D. DeVecchia #34. I handed a set of building keys to LT DeVecchia and informed him that we had completed the sweep of the scene and we were unable to locate any other suspects. I informed him that I was turning the scene over to him and WDMC at that point. I then briefed him on our operation and conducted a walk-through

with him. I also directed all SPTU personnel to an assembly area nearby in the school parking lot.



A short time later, LT DeVecchia informed me that information had been developed about the residence at #36 Yogananda St, Newtown which was associated with the suspected shooter. I then assembled the available members of both SPTU West and East and we responded to a staging area near that residence. We relieved initial responding Newtown and CSP patrol personnel and commenced tactical operations at #36 Yogananda Street as it was believed additional victims or suspects may be in the residence.

During the initial stages of the tactical operation at #36 Yoganada Street, I was contacted by Major B. Meraviglia, the Western District Commander, and requested to return to the school and check additional areas. I then turned over tactical command of the Yogananda scene to SGT R. Palen #270 and SPTU-E. I redeployed back to the Sandy Hook Elementary School with SPTU-W via our RG-12 armored vehicle.

After conducting another sweep of the school, I directed SPTU - W to remain on sight in an assembly area in the schoolyard.

While engaged in activities near the entrance to the school, I was made aware of information that became known to investigators relating to the identity of the deceased suspect in the school. There were reports that the deceased subject in the school was either Ryan or Adam LANZA. During this time, FBI Special Agent Lisa Skelly-Byrnes indicated she had Department of Motor Vehicle comparison photos of both Adam LANZA and his brother Ryan Lanza. In an effort to make a preliminary identification of the shooter, based on photographs that were obtained by the FBI, Special Agent L. Skelly-Byrnes and I re-entered the school and conducted a comparison of those photos and the deceased. Based on that comparison, it appeared likely that the suspect was Adam LANZA. We then took a photo of the deceased using SA Skelly-Byrnes iphone. That photo was relayed to investigators at approximately 1400 hrs

CASE STATUS: The case remains active.

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
