MISCELLANEOUS:

Upon inspection of the suspected bullet strike, investigators noted the strike first entered the lower front bumper cover in the center area nearest the front license plate. The strike traveled into the lower driver's side portion of the vehicle's radiator. The projectile did not appear to exit the vehicle's radiator. The vehicle's radiator was not manipulated at the scene in an attempt to retrieve the projectile and/or fragments. Suspected fragments were located on the asphalt surface beneath the suspected strike to the radiator and collected as evidentiary item 509.
