Action Taken:On Friday, December 14, 2012, investigators of the Central District Major Crime Squad were<br/>requested by the Western District Major Crime Squad to assist with the vehicle processing of<br/>a 2010 black Honda Civic bearing Connecticut registration 872YEO, VIN#<br/>2HGFA1F51AH542299. The vehicle was located in front of the main entrance of the Sandy<br/>Hook Elementary School, parked in a no parking zone. The vehicle was suspected to be<br/>operated by the suspect Adam Lanza (DOB 04/22/82). The vehicle was seized and processed<br/>under the legal authority of a Search and Seizure warrant obtained by the members of the<br/>Connecticut State Police. During the initial stages of the investigation, investigators<br/>conducted a cursory search of the vehicle including the trunk and located a Siaga 12 Shotgun,<br/>serial #H08402282, with two magazines containing 20 rounds of ammunition (Exhibit # 505).<br/>The weapon was made safe, seized and turned over to Detective Keith of WDMC at<br/>approximately 0005 hours on December 15, 2012. The vehicle was later transported to Troop<br/>A – Southbury, where it was processed on December 21, 2012 by investigators.

The vehicle was processed at Troop A - Southbury, located at 90 Lakeside Road in the Town of Southbury, Connecticut. Processing consisted of investigators swabbing various interior and exterior surfaces of the vehicle, documenting the vehicle with video, digital photography, completing a motor vehicle survey and examining the interior and exterior of the vehicle for latent fingerprints and shoe impressions. Processing began at approximately 1211 hours and ended at approximately 1342 hours.

Investigators examined the entire vehicle for identifiable latent fingerprints. The process for developing latent prints consisted of the conventional method utilizing volcanic powder applied with fiberglass brushes on the surfaces conducive to fingerprinting. Investigators yielded negative results for latent prints, but a shoe impression was lifted from the front
