

**Summary of Incident:** On December 14, 2012 at approximately 0935 hours, the Newtown Police Department and the Connecticut State Police responded to an active shooter situation at Sandy Hook Elementary School located at 12 Dickinson Drive in Newtown, Connecticut. The incident involved the suspect, Adam Lanza (DOB 04/22/82), who entered the school, shot and murdered numerous victims, which ultimately ended with Adam Lanza dying of a self inflicted gunshot wound. The suspect reportedly traveled from his residence to the Sandy Hook Elementary School utilizing a 2010 black Honda Civic bearing Connecticut registration 872YEO, VIN# 2HGFA1F51AH542299, which was registered to Nancy Lanza. This vehicle was located in front of the main entrance of the Sandy Hook Elementary School, parked in a no parking zone. The Connecticut State Police Crash




The exterior of the vehicle had minor scratches and minor contact damage to the front passenger side quarter panel. The interior of the vehicle appeared to be recently cleaned out with only three personal items in the entire vehicle. The personal items included a pair of sunglasses and a package of Kleenex located in the center console. Additionally, there was an Aveeno brand shampoo bottle located under the passenger front seat. Nothing was located in the glove compartment. The interior was very clean and in excellent condition.

**Evidence:** During the course of this investigation, the Connecticut State Police Central District Major Crime Squad processed the above listed vehicle and seized ten (10) items of evidence. The evidence seized consisted of a Siaga 12 Shotgun with two magazines containing 20 rounds of ammunition and swabbings of various exterior surfaces for the purposes of identifying a potential DNA source. Investigators also identified and lifted a shoe impression from the front passenger side door of the vehicle. All evidence items are detailed on separate evidence report.

Evidence item five hundred and five (505) was turned over to Detective Keith of WDMC on December 15, 2012 approximately 0008 hours. At the conclusion of the vehicle processing on December 21, 2012 at approximately 1330 hours, evidence items five hundred and eleven (511) through five hundred and nineteen (519) were turned over to the TFC Gravel #388 of the Connecticut State Police, Troop A.




**Action Taken:**

On Friday, December 14, 2012, investigators of the Central District Major Crime Squad were requested by the Western District Major Crime Squad to assist with the vehicle processing of a 2010 black Honda Civic bearing Connecticut registration 872YEO, VIN# 2HGFA1F51AH542299. The vehicle was located in front of the main entrance of the Sandy Hook Elementary School, parked in a no parking zone. The vehicle was suspected to be operated by the suspect Adam Lanza (DOB 04/22/82). The vehicle was seized and processed under the legal authority of a Search and Seizure warrant obtained by the members of the Connecticut State Police. During the initial stages of the investigation, investigators obtained information that the vehicle possibly contained a weapon located in the trunk. Investigators conducted a cursory search of the vehicle including the trunk and located a Siaga 12 Shotgun, serial #H08402282, with two magazines containing 20 rounds of ammunition (Exhibit # 505). The weapon was made safe, seized and turned over to Detective Keith of WDMC at approximately 0005 hours on December 15, 2012. The vehicle was later transported to Troop A – Southbury, where it was processed on December 21, 2012 by investigators.

The vehicle was processed at Troop A - Southbury, located at 90 Lakeside Road in the Town of Southbury, Connecticut. Processing consisted of investigators swabbing various interior and exterior surfaces of the vehicle, documenting the vehicle with video, digital photography, completing a motor vehicle survey and examining the interior and exterior of the vehicle for latent fingerprints and shoe impressions. Processing began at approximately 1211 hours and ended at approximately 1342 hours.

Investigators examined the entire vehicle for identifiable latent fingerprints. The process for developing latent prints consisted of the conventional method utilizing volcanic powder applied with fiberglass brushes on the surfaces conducive to fingerprinting. Investigators yielded negative results for latent prints, but a shoe impression was lifted from the front

passenger door (Exhibit #515). Investigators then conducted a systematic search of the vehicle at which time investigators identified numerous possible DNA sources. Evidence items #511 through #514 consisted of DNA swabbings from the exterior door handles of the vehicle. Evidence items #516 through #519 consisted of DNA swabbings from the interior door handles of the vehicle.

At the conclusion of the vehicle processing on December 21, 2012 at approximately 1330 hours, evidence items five hundred and eleven (511) through five hundred and nineteen (519) were turned over to the TFC Gravel #388 of the Connecticut State Police, Troop A.
