The following photographs, numbered one (01) through one hundred fifty-seven (157), submitted on photography proof sheets, were taken by this investigator on Sunday, December 16, 2012, during the course of scene processing at the Sandy Hook Elementary School in Newtown, Connecticut.

On Friday, December 14, 2012, Connecticut State Police personnel responded to the Sandy Hook Elementary School at 12 Dickenson Drive, Sandy Hook, Connecticut, to assist the Newtown Police Department with a reported active shooting incident. Upon arrival, law enforcement personnel confirmed the active shooting incident with multiple fatalities. Connecticut State Police – Major Crime Squad personnel were subsequently assigned to assist with the investigation.

The attached photographs were taken utilizing a Department issued Nikon D300 programmable digital camera. Auxiliary light sources and/or flash were utilized when necessary. The photographs were stored on an Efilm 4GB Compact Flash digital media card. Following documentation, the digital media card was downloaded onto a compact disc and forwarded to the State of Connecticut, Forensic Laboratory. The photographs were printed onto photography paper and additional compact discs were made. The digital media card has since been reformatted and no longer contains images of the scene.

All attached photographs depict images of the doors, door knobs, locking mechanisms located within the elassrooms, conference rooms, and offices within the northeast corridor where suspect Adam Lanza accessed during the shooting incident. The photographs also depict doors, door knobs and locking mechanisms within the school's main office, including the Principal's office and Nurse's office. The purpose of the photographs was to document the conditions of the doors and aid investigators with documentation. Furthermore, the photographs were taken to supplement Detective R. Insalaco's (#748) documenting report pertaining to the conditions of doors, door knobs, and locking mechanisms.
