SECONDARY DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY REPORT

On Friday, December 14, 2012 at approximately 0935 hours, the Newtown Police Department and the Connecticut State Police responded to an active shooter situation at Sandy Hook Elementary School located at 12 Dickinson Drive in Newtown, Connecticut. The incident involved the suspect Adam Lanza (DOB 04/22/82), who entered the school and shot and murdered numerous victims, which ultimately ended with Adam Lanza dying of a self inflicted gunshot wound. The Central District Major Crime Squad was requested to assist the Western District Major Crime Squad in processing the scene at the Sandy Hook Elementary School located at 12 Dickinson Drive in Newtown, Connecticut. The following photographs were taken on December 14, 2012 as part of scene processing and are images of the victims of the homicide scene. The photographs were taken for victim identification purposes.

The following color photographs, being submitted as proof sheets, were taken by this investigator during the scene processing. The photographs taken during the course of processing the scene depict images of the scene and evidentiary items seized. The attached photographs are being submitted as back up photographs to the photographs taken during the course of processing. The color photographs were taken utilizing the unit's assigned NIKON D300 digital programmable camera. The built in flash and/or artificial lighting was utilized when necessary. The images were stored on a Lexar 1GB digital media card. The images were transferred to a CD and printed by the Connecticut State Police Forensic Laboratory. The digital media card was reformatted for future use and no longer contains the images captured at this incident.

The status of the investigation remains active.
