**REQUEST FOR LAB EXAMINATION OF ADAM LANZA'S GAME SYSTEMS**

**ACTION TAKEN:** On Thursday July 25, 2013 I transported the following items to the Forensic Lab in Meriden for the purpose of having them analyzed by the computer crimes section. All items were seized from the Lanza home located at 36 Yogananda Street in Sandy Hook CT. The items are as follows:

- Exhibit #3 One Sony Play Station 2 with Controller + memory card
- Exhibit #12 One (1) Microsoft "XBOX" with partially obliterated serial number
- Exhibit #43 One (1) XBOX 360

These items were received as evidence at that lab at 1358 hours and assigned submission #'s 126, 127 and 128. At the time of the submission of these items I also presented a prepared Request for Examination of Physical Evidence form and Incoming Evidence Checklist (QR-CC-1) as well as a copy of the search and seizure warrant that granted the authority to examine the evidence. Copies of the Request for examination form, Incoming Evidence Checklist and search warrant are attached to this report. Also attached to this report is a copy of the evidence receipt given to me upon the completion of the submission.

The documents noted above have been uploaded into LEAS and are accessible through the Major Crime Tab.

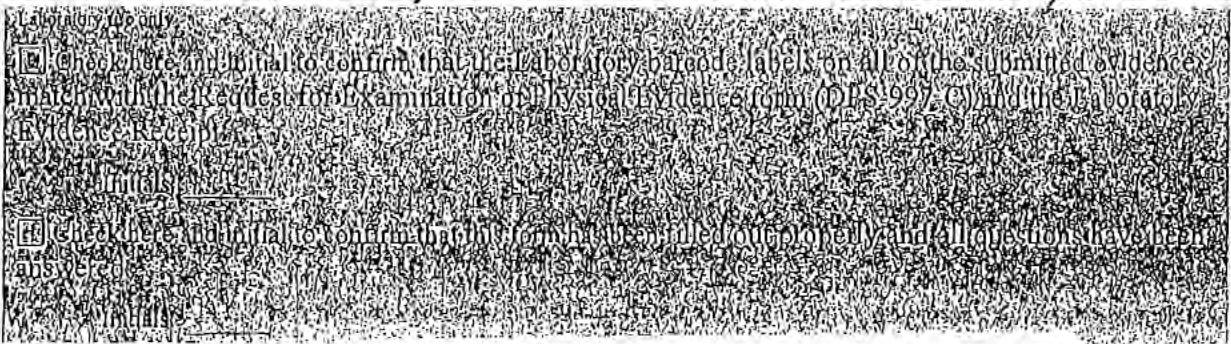

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
Sir,

On 7-24-13 I repackaged evidence that was returned to Western District Major Crime from the FBI lab. In the evidence returned were exhibits from two separate case numbers, CFS-12-00704559, the original case number for the Sandy Hook Elementary School (SHES) shooting, and CFS-12-00705354, the case number established for the murder investigation of Nancy Lanza at 36 Yogananda Street in Sandy Hook. The evidence was being repackaged to be submitted to the Connecticut forensic lab for examination by the state. A copy of a warrant showing case number 12-00704559, giving the authority to examine the evidence labeled 12-00705354, was faxed to Troop G to accompany the evidence to be submitted to the lab.

The writing on the packages for exhibits #3, #12 and #43 show they were seized from 36 Yogananda Street, under case #12-00705354, the case number for the murder of Nancy Lanza. Page 6 of the warrant for case number 12-00704559, the overall case number for the shooting at SHES, show that exhibits #3, #12 and #43 being seized pursuant to that case number for the overall shooting. The case number on the evidence does not correspond to the case number on the warrant. Page 6 of the warrant for 12-00704559 records the evidence seized for that case, but is labeled for 12-00705354.

On 7-25-13 I alerted Detective Bill Flynn of the discrepancy prior to him delivering the evidence to the lab for examination. I was later informed by Det. Flynn that a totally separate case number had been established solely for the collection of evidence to eliminate case number crossovers.
