



I then transported them in my department assigned vehicle (488-WHK) back to Troop A in Southbury where I secured them in the WDMC-A temporary evidence locker at approx. 1620 hrs..

On 02/06/13 at approx. 1500 hrs., I took these exhibits, as well as Ex. #93 (Lynksys Wireless Router) out of the WDMC-A temporary evidence locker and gave them directly to the Troop A Evidence Officer, TFC Lonny Mo #998.
