

EVIDENCE REPORT

The incident involved the suspect, Adam Lanza (DOB 04/22/82), who entered the school, shot and murdered numerous victims, which ultimately ended with Adam Lanza dying of a self inflicted gunshot wound. It was later determined that prior to Adam Lanza arriving at the Sandy Hook Elementary School, he had shot and murdered his mother, Nancy Lanza, at their residence located at 36 Yogananda Street, Sandy Hook, Connecticut.

Action Taken:

On Wednesday, December 19, 2012 at approximately 1015 hours, Connecticut State Police Central District Major Crime investigators were assigned by Sgt. Thomas to complete a search of the Lanza residence located at 36 Yogananda Street, Sandy Hook, Connecticut. The search was conducted under the legal authority of a Search and Seizure Warrant. A search of the exterior of the residence yielded negative results for items of evidentiary value. A search of the interior of the residence yielded thirty-four (34) items of evidentiary value. 



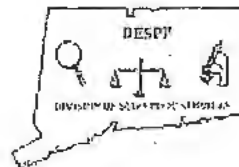
