#### Answering Machine Audio Recording

Home Phone of 36 Yogananda St. Sandy Hook, CT

#### Action Taken:

On Saturday, December 15, 2012 at approximately 0215 hours I played and simultaneously recorded the messages left on the house telephone answering machine located in the first floor office/den of 36 Yogananda Street Sandy Hook, Connecticut.

The messages were digitally recorded, using an Olympus W5200 PC digital recorder. The recording was subsequently transferred to a Maxell CD-R, which was secured in evidence as item #96. Additional copies were produced with one copy attached and one copy stored at Eastern District Major Crime Headquarters, located in Norwich, Connecticut.

The home telephone number listed for Nancy Lanza of 36 Yogananda Street in Sandy Hook, Connecticut is (203) 426-8167.

Several of the messages left have irregularities or inaudible portions in the messages. The recording is consistent with how the answering machine played at the time of recording. The stated day and time is the automated voice of the answering machine

#### **ACTION TAKEN:**

On 12-14-12, The Newtown Police Department, along with Troopers from Troop A in Southbury responded to the school shooting at the Sandy Hook School in Newtown (CFS12-00704559). As a result of that investigation. ESU responded to the suspects (ADAM LANZA) residence at 36 Yogananda St., in Sandy Hook where Lanza's mother Nancy Lanza, was found deceased. The Connecticut State Police -Central District Major Crime Squad completed numerous search warrants for the residence, and The Connecticut State Police -Eastern District Major Crime Squad was requested and assigned the investigation at 36 Yogananda St., in Sandy Hook, CT (see supplemental Reports, and Search Warrant Reports for details).

During the search, the following items, among many others, were located and seized:

- Item #77 One blue folder labeled, "Guns" containing various receipts, paperwork, "Sale and Transfer of all Firearms" form, and other firearm related paperwork, forms and notes in the name of Nancy Lanza seized from inside bankers box on floor in office/study, first floor main level, 36 Yogananda St., Sandy Hook.
- Item #81 One piece of paperwork titled, "Connecticut Gun Exchange Glock 20SF 10MM FS 15RD FC" dated 12-21-11, seized from top drawer of cabinet in office/study, first floor main level, 36 Yogananda St., Sandy Hook.

On 12/14/2012 at approximately 1015 hours I responded to the Sandy Hook Elementary School in the Town of Newtown, CT for a reported active shooter incident. I arrived at the school at approximately 1033 hours and observed a large number of emergency vehicles and emergency personnel at the scene. I approached TFC. Paul Macisco #906 and was informed that there was possibly two (2) gunman involved in the shooting incident. Lt. Michael Davis #053 was coordinating response efforts in the parking area of the school, which held numerous parked and unoccupied vehicles. State and local police were conducting searches of the school and evacuating civilian personnel. I directed TFC, Macisco to obtain all of the license plate numbers belonging to the parked vehicles and to be observant of any possible secondary incendiary devices in the area.

I was approached by the Newtown Police Chief, Michael Kehoe, who reported that there were numerous fatalities within the Sandy Hook Elementary School, including both faculty staff and students. Search efforts within the school were ongoing and information suggested that a second gunman was possibly in the surrounding area.


I entered the Sandy Hook Elementary School and was logged into the crime scene by Newtown Police Officer Lorancaitis. I subsequently observed two (2) deceased adult females lying on the floor area within the front lobby of the school in a large pool of blood. I traveled to the left down a hallway whereupon I observed a deceased white male, later identified as Adam Lanza (DOB 04/22/1992), lying on the floor of a classroom on the left side of the hallway. I then exited the crime scene upon being assigned to assume command of a secondary scene located at 36 Yogananda Street in the Town of Newtown.

During a discussion with Chief Kehoe, I asked if he desired the Connecticut State Police Public Information Office to handle media attention, which he then requested and I subsequently contacted Lt. J. Paul Vance #073 to inform him of the request by the Newtown Police Chief. It was subsequently determined that the media staging area would be conducted at Tredwell Park located on Philo Curtis Road in the Town of Newtown. On 12/14/2012 at approximately 1120 hours TFC. Terry Bellanca #425 and I responded to 36 Yogananda Street in the Town of Newtown. Upon arrival we were met by TFC. David Gutierrez #1404 and TFC. Michael Trotman #617, who had secured a perimeter at the residence along with Newtown Police Officers Michael McGowan and John McCluskey. Troopers Gutierrez and Trotman had obtained information regarding the Lanza

residence from area neighbors upon conducting an adjacent neighborhood canvass.

The residence at 36 Yogananda had been secured from entry by any persons and it was unknown if any additional perpetrators and/or victims were within the residence. I directed security posts at the intersections of Charter Ridge and Bresson Farms Road, respectively. A media staging area subsequently formed at the intersection of Bresson Farms Road and Yogananda Street. The Connecticut State Police Emergency Services Unit was contacted for response to the scene for the purposes of entering and searching the residence located at 36 Yogananda Street.

On 12/14/2012 at approximately 1147 hours I telephoned phone exchange (203) 426-8167, which was assigned to the Lanza residence located at 36 Yogananda Street in Newtown, CT. Upon telephoning the residence I was presented with a voice mail box recorded message. I left a verbal message within the residence and identified my rank, name and affiliation with the Connecticut State Police, requesting anyone in the residence to answer the phone. There was no answer after a period of time and I subsequently ended the phone call.

On 12/14/2012 at approximately 1213 hours Sgt. Palen #270 and Sgt. Bartolotta #161, who are members of the Connecticut State Police Emergency Services Unit arrived at the scene. The following information was derived from field notes compiled by Sgt. Bartolotta while located at 36 Yogananda Street. A chronological timeline of events is as follows:

At 9:40 AM on 14 December 2012, initial call-in to Newtown emergency services (911) was received from Sandy Hook Elementary School in Newtown, Connecticut, that shots had been fired within the school. The gunman, Adam P. Lanza, (DOB:04/22/1992) shot out the windows at the front of the elementary school in order to gain access. Two law enforcement officers arrived during the shooting, at which time the suspect ducked into a classroom and shot himself. The shooter attended the school as a child, but no other relationship between Adam P. Lanza and Sandy Hook Elementary School has been established. There were a total of 28 dead, 20 children and 8 adults (seven at the school, including the gunman, and his mother at their 36 Yogananda Street residence).

Transfer of 36 Yogananda

On 12/23/2012 I was informed that the residence at 36 Yogananda had not been properly secured or cleaned since the initial incident. I went to the residence and found that this was true. I contacted the FBI and spoke with Kyle Scherrer who authorized Aftermath Specialists to conduct the crime scene clean up. I spoke with Bill Ciaccio (508) 328-4797 the regional supervisor for Aftermath, who said that he would have a crew at the residence the morning of 12/24/12. Redding Chief Fuchs contacted a representative from Home Depot who said that they would be able to come to the residence in the afternoon of 12/24/2012 to board up and secure the exterior.

I was contacted by Mike Harkins (646)241-7422 of Risk Control Strategies indicting that he was contracted by Attorney Mike English who represented the Lanza estate. The identity of Mike Harkins was verified by FBI special agent Michael Zuk, who had been at the EOC with me the week before. Harkins wanted to know when the residence was going to be turned over so that he could schedule security. I spoke with Attorney English (347) 628-9470 who put me in contact with Peter Lanza 103 10 Peter verified that English represented him and Ryan and that the property could be turned over to Risk Control Strategies. English sent me an email verifying his affiliation with the Lanza family.

On 12/24/2012 Newtown officers Hull and Mulhall were at the residence and oversaw the clean up and securement of the residence. They took photos of the exterior of the residence to verify that it was secured. On 12/24/2012, I attempted to contact Peter to notify him that the residence would be able to be turned over later that day, but there was no answer and the ail box was not established. I spoke with Harkins and informed him that the residence would be secured by a police officer .til 2359 hours on 12/24/2012 and that he needed to have his security in place by then. He stated he would. I spoke with Michael English and at 1329 hours I sent him an email:

This is to notify you that the residence at 36 Yogananda will be able to be turned over to Risk Control, the private security company the Lanzas had contracted, after 1800 hrs (6:00 pm) tonight 12/24/2012. I have spoken with Michael Harkins (646) 241-7422 of Risk Control and notified him of this. We will have an officer on the property and continue the security detail until midnight tonight, 12/24/2012. The building has been secured and there is a pad lock on one door. The officer on scene will have the key to the pad lock, but if the private security detail does not arrive prior to 2400 hours, the officer will bring and leave the key at the Newtown Police Department Dispatch. Any questions or additional information can be directed to the shift supervisor, Sqt. Steven Santucci, at the police department (203) 426-5841.

Sgt. Santucci stated later that the transition was made without incident.
