

DATE/TIME: On Thursday January 3, 2013 at approximately 1100 hours.


ASSIGNMENT: Obtain information on Nancy Lanza's stay at the Mount Washington Resort.

ACTION TAKEN: On the above date and time Detective Jeffery R. Payette and this writer arrived at the Mount Washington Resort Hotel in Bretton Woods, NH. At that time we met with several members of the Mount Washington Resort staff in the Managing Director's office. We met with Resort Manager Calvin Belknap, Loss Prevention Manager Michael B. McHale II and Managing Director Stephen Hilliard.



The resort staff was very cooperative and offered to assist with the investigation. It was confirmed that Nancy Lanza checked in to the resort on December 11, 2012 at 12:10 pm. Based on staff recollection, the issuance of one room key and the documented restaurant meals that appeared to be for one person it is believed that Nancy Lanza stayed at the resort alone and checked out on December 13, 2012 at 12:27 pm. Mr. Hilliard indicated that the resort had printed records of Nancy Lanza's purchases at the resort during her stay. Mr. Hilliard contacted a representative from the Omni Resort legal office and learned that the company required a written request for the release of any paperwork documenting Nancy Lanza's stay at the resort.

Mr. Hilliard further reported that several people had called the resort the week prior claiming to represent various news agencies inquiring about Nancy Lanza's stay at the resort.

Brian agreed to speak with us about his knowledge and recollection of making an oil delivery to the Lanza's residence on Friday December 14th, 2012. Brian stated verbally and later in a written statement among other things, that on Friday December 14th, 2012 between 9:30AM and 10:00AM, he went to #36 Yogananda Street in Sandy Hook, Connecticut, where he made an oil delivery at that residence. Brian further stated that when he made this oil delivery, he did not see any vehicles or people in the driveway or at the house. Brian stated that the garage bay doors were closed. Brian stated that he has never seen anyone at the house in the past 5 to 6 years that he has been making oil deliveries to this house. Brian stated that he does not know the people that live at #36 Yogananda Street Sandy Hook, CT., and that he does not know Nancy or Adam Lanza. Brian stated that after he made the oil delivery at #36 Yogananda Street, he put the delivery receipt/slip in the mailbox at the roadside, and then believed that he proceeded to #12 Yogananda Street Sandy Hook, CT., to make a separate oil delivery.

The interview took place in the dining room of [REDACTED] 04. Present during the interview were detective Richard Covello #376 and I. The interview began on December 15, 2012 at approximately 1620 hours and ended on December 15, 2012 at approximately 1636 hours.

04 related that he had been expecting to be contacted by police at some point in light of recent events in Newtown. He was initially guarded during discussions related to 04. He described that it was 04 and that Nancy was as well as 04. As we spoke, 04 identified that one of his main concerns was the media obtaining the information that he was sharing regarding 04. I explained to 04 that our investigation was active and as such we were not releasing such information and related statements by witnesses to the media.

04 further related the he 04. That she went on a trip to New Hampshire Tuesday, December 11th, 2012. 04 left for a business trip on Wednesday, December 12th, 2012. He received a text message from Nancy at approximately 2200hrs on Thursday, December 13th in which Nancy informed him that she recently arrived home. That they last talked on Thursday, December 13th, 2012 at approximately 2222hrs. At that time he was in 04 and they discussed her trip and his business trip.

04 thereafter texted Nancy Friday morning, December 14th at approximately 1012hrs to say 04. He did not immediately, or shortly thereafter, receive any response from Nancy, which 04 described as not being unusual. Later that day, 04 boss notified him of the shooting in Newtown. 04 searched the topic on-line and contacted family members in Newtown to make inquiries. He then attempted to contact Nancy on her home telephone and cellular telephone just around noon time with negative results. He described that Nancy's home telephone did not ring and went directly to voice mail. Sometime thereafter, 04 heard the name "Ryan Lanza" being talked about in connection with the shooting as well the incident taking place at Yagalanda Street. At this point 04 called a friend who confirmed Nancy's death.

04 related that he never thought Nancy's son Ryan would be involved in such an incident. He was aware that Nancy had another son, Adam, who suffered from Asperger Syndrome. He never met Adam and had only been inside Nancy's residence once, approximately a year and a half ago. That Nancy never related any incidents in which Adam was violent with her. However, 04 felt that Nancy did a lot for Adam to assure that he was happy and appeased.

04 related that during the time that he had known Nancy, she had shared with him that she owned guns and that she had been to a range target shooting with her sons.

In addition to the information contained in 04 statement, he verbally related to these Detectives that over the past year Nancy had shared with him her plans to sell her home in Newtown and move to either Washington or North Carolina. That she was originally going to downsize to a smaller

home in Newtown. However, she had conversations with her son Ryan about the idea of moving. 04 explained that it appeared that with Ryan living and working out of state and his desire to travel, there was no reason that she should restrict herself to living in Newtown.

According to 04, Nancy had planned to have her house painted over this past spring in preparation for putting it up for sale. However, the painting plan did not come to fruition and the sale of the house was postponed. Further, 04 related that Nancy knew that she was not going to be able to effectively show / sell her home while Adam was living within. Her plan was to purchase an RV (Recreational Vehicle) to facilitate their move to either Washington State or North Carolina. During their trip, 04 related that Nancy would then sleep in a motel / hotel and Adam would sleep in the RV as he would not sleep in a motel / hotel. In this process, she could have Adam out of the house, they could effectuate their move and meanwhile sell her house.

04 related that it was his understanding that if Nancy were to move to Washington State, it was for the purpose of enrolling Adam in a special school that he wanted to attend. If they were to move to North Carolina, it was going to be for the purpose of obtaining employment for Adam and making him more self sufficient. That Nancy had related to 04 that she had a friend, "John", who owned a computer technologies business in North Carolina. That John had agreed to mentor Adam and teach him the business. (See Attached Written Statement)

RELATED EVIDENCE:

During my interview with 04, he referenced his cellular telephone for obtaining dates and times of communications that he had with Nancy Lanza. He allowed me to view and visually verify the related text message communications. He showed me one text message dated Monday, December 10th, 2012 with a time stamp of 1151hrs. The message was received from Nancy Lanza and related that she had gotten off to a rough start that day. That Adam had "bumped his head" "really bad" and they were dealing with blood at 5:30 in the morning.

I explained to 04 that his cellular telephone contained communications known to me, and presumably some communications not yet viewed, that were considered to have evidentiary value. That this information on his cellular telephone could help identify critical timelines related to time of death and possibly identify precipitating circumstances leading up to Nancy's death. As such, I was obligated to seize his telephone at this time and apply for a search warrant to search its contents. I explained that I also could accept 04 written consent to search his telephone in which case the process of extracting the related information and returning his telephone could be effectuated this same day. On Sunday, December 16th, 2012 at approximately 1105hrs, 04 verbally agreed to provide consent and thereafter completed a written consent form. (See Attached Form)

- He met Nancy Champion (Lanza) in the late 1970's as 04 [REDACTED]. He also was a friend of Nancy Lanza's mother in the 1970's.
- In the summer of 2012 he was contacted by Nancy Lanza. They met for lunch at the Three Tomatoes Restaurant in Lebanon, NH to catch up on 12-13-2012 at about 1:10 PM. Nancy Lanza told 04 [REDACTED] that she had married a high school boyfriend and divorced. She spoke of two sons. Her son Ryan was on his own living in New Jersey and her son Adam had disabilities. She said Adam had some sort of autism.
- 04 [REDACTED] said that Nancy described a difficult life but gave him the impression that she was courageous and "handling everything". Nancy told 04 [REDACTED] she was very proud of Adam's accomplishments.
- 04 [REDACTED] said that Nancy Lanza told him she had no intentions of re-marrying and accepted the obligations of caring for Adam. Nancy said that she and Adam planned for her trip to New Hampshire. The trip was an experiment to allow Adam to stay at home alone for a few days.

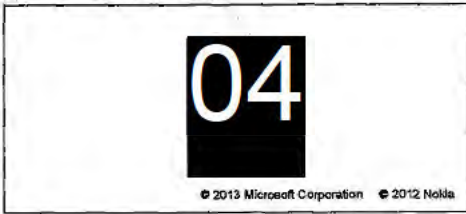
